** From January to March five persons were allegedly extra judicially killed by the law enforcement agencies during political violence which is also included in the statistical part of the Political Violence.

*** During City Corporation polls (April 28, 2015) 134 persons were injured and during Municipality polls (December 30, 2015) five persons were killed and 1203 were injured.

****It is to be noted that numerous women became victims of sexual harassment in Dhaka University campus during celebrations of Bangla New year (Pohela Boishak) on April 14, 2015. The number could not be determined as the victims did not report the incidents. Therefore the number of sexual harassment/stalking against women could not be added to the statistical part of sexual harassment/stalking.
